ABOUT THE PROJECT

Co-funded by the European Union, the overall objective of the Transform project is to support educational centers across Europe to become places of inclusivity through the development of new pedagogic materials and innovative approaches to teaching and learning.

This project will support the horizontal area of inclusion and diversity in all fields of education, training, youth and sport.

1st Transform Learning, Teaching and Training Activity in Athens!

The 1st Transform Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity took place in Athens from July 8th to 10th, hosted by Xenios Polis at Athens' School of Public Health.

This event brought together project partners, VET educators, and learners to pilot-test the 'Introducing Inclusion and Integration' course through interactive workshops. Participants engaged in hands-on activities addressing discrimination, inclusion strategies, and advocacy development, providing valuable feedback to refine the training materials. Key sessions included bias intervention exercises and intercultural communication workshops. The LTTA concluded with a visit to the Irish Embassy, where Meath Partnership presented the project's objectives and secured commitments for collaboration. Based on what we learned, the final course is being updated now.
